Cabinets	<i>Lemon Oil (Wilburs)</i>	<i>Twice a year</i>
Toilet Bowl Rings	<i>Pumice Stone; Efferdent Tablets</i>	<i>Once a month</i>
Cultured Marble	<i>Gel Gloss</i>	<i>Twice a year</i>
Ceramic Bath Tile	<i>Car Wax - white or clear</i>	<i>At move in; Twice a year</i>
Glass Shower Door	<i>Car Wax or Rain - X</i>	<i>At move in; Twice a year</i>
Porcelain Sinks/Tubs	<i>Soft Scrub; Barkeeper's Friend</i>	<i>Once a week</i>
Stainless Steel Sinks	<i>Gel Gloss; Windex; Lemon Oil</i>	<i>Once a week</i>
Fiberglass Tub	<i>Gel Gloss</i>	<i>Once a month</i>
Vinyl Floors	<i>Any No-Wax Cleaner</i>	<i>Once a week</i>
Windows	<i>Silicone Spray</i>	<i>When they stick</i>
Windows Screens	<i>Tide Detergent; Simple Green</i>	<i>Twice a year/ as needed</i>
Wood Front Doors	<i>Teak Oil</i>	<i>Twice a year</i>
Wood Gate Slats	<i>Linseed Oil</i>	<i>Twice a year</i>

Have your heat/cooling unit serviced once a year by a licensed contractor. Change your filter every month. The size of your filter is listed on the side of the filter. A good reminder: change your filter when you receive your monthly utility bill.

Re-caulking is necessary in tubs, showers, at baseboards, etc. as needed.

Drain your water heater every six months
